CLUB PARTICIPATION FAQ's

WHEN ARE THE GENERAL MEETINGS AND WHAT IS INVOLVED?

General Meetings are the first Wednesdays of the months of September through June. Doors open at 9 a.m. for our social time and meetings start at 10 a.m. Lunch reservations are made through an online program called Greenvelope and the cost is \$20 at the door. If you do not want lunch, it is \$5 to attend the meeting. Members are required to attend at least one meeting annually. Meetings include Club business, Chair and Committee reports, fundraising ideas, a short program and lunch.

LUNCHEON COMMITTEE

A luncheon committee is organized monthly to select the luncheon menu, provide appropriate decor, select table linens, and provide the punch. Each member is required to serve on one luncheon committee during the year. The Amenities Chair creates the committees using theinformation provided on the Membership Application form. If unable to serve on an assigned date, the member is responsible for 'swapping' with another member and advising the Amenities Chair of the change (in the event of absence without a substitute, a member will be responsible for a \$20 Hostess fee).

WHAT ARE THE WAYS & MEANS FUNCTIONS AND HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

Members are expected to participate in raising monies for our service activities in the community. When the Committee Chair calls those who have signed up (on the application form), the member is expected to help. Please see the below events for details.

Friendship Soup Mix: This major fundraiser requires the creation and decoration of dry soup packages by members working together. A small group of members sells the soup at various boutiques and events.

Bunco: A fun game night for members and guests! This fundraiser needs members to work on planning, advertising, ect.

Tea and Fashion Show: This daytime event includes individually decorated tables for a luncheon and fashion show.
